### Revised J10 – National Judging Scheme

The J10 form has recently been completely re-written and the new version is available on the Judges section of the AGB website.

There are several important changes, which cover the requirements judges have to fulfil before applying for assessments to a higher grade, and prior to sitting the re-assessment exams for Regional & National judges.

The form is attached to the email this newsletter came with and I strongly advise you all to read the sections that are relevant to your current grade and the assessment criteria for advancing to the higher grades.
